Aires A. Nascimento Emeritus Professor of Ancient Languages (Greek and Latin) ate University of Lisbon, where he coordinated the teaching of Classical Languages, Medieval Latin Philology, Codex and History of Ancient Texts. Coordinator of several research projects. Former director of Centre for Classical Studies (UL). Former Director of the indexed Journal Euphrosyne. Is member of several national and international Academies, as, for instance: Lisbon Academy of Sciences, Portuguese Academy of History, Academy Properziana del Subasio (Assis), SISMEL (Florença), ISIME (Roma), Academy de Bones Lletres (Barcelona), AHLM (Hispanic Association of Medieval Literature), Academia Auriense-Mindoniense de San Rosendo, etc. He is member of the Directive Board of several national and international indexed journals.

He is the author of a vast bibliography: more than 350 articles, more than 30 monographies on the following subjects: Latin Medieval Literature, History of the Codex and illumination, Critical editions of Medieval Latin texts, Latin hagiography, Portuguese Humanist Culture, Humanist Culture and Literature, etc. He is the author of the critical edition, translation and commentary of More's *Utopia* (Fundação Calouste Gulbenkian, 2006). This edition earned him the prestigious "Grand Award for Translation" (2007) given by União Latina/FCT and also the Pen Club Award (2007)
