Tiziana **BASIRICÒ** is Associate Professor at the University of Enna "Kore" (2014-today). Born in 1973, she studied Civil Engineering (1992-2000) and she got PhD in Civil engineering: Project and recovery, at the University of Palermo in 2005. She was Research Fellow (2006-2010), Assistant Professor (2010-2014) and then, since 2014, Associate Professor of Technical Architecture and Construction Design at the University of Enna "Kore", Faculty of Engineering and Architecture.

She teaches "Technical Architecture" to Civil Engineering students and "Technology of the Architecture" and "Laboratory of Design and Construction" to Architecture students of the International single cycle degree course, together with the "Escola Tècnica Superior d'Arquitectura del Vallès (ETSAV)" of the Polytechnic University of the Catalunya, in Barcelona. Her researches regard with the History of Construction and the conservation of modern architecture, particularly the architectures realized between the two World Wars (rural villages and sanatoriums) and after the 2nd World War (public housing) and the techniques of energy retrofitting.

She worked on research projects financed by the Italian Ministry of Education, University and Research (PRIN, Project of Relevant National Interest) since 2000 to 2012 on the Italian Construction History.
