Maria do Rosário PIMENTEL graduated in History at Universidade de Coimbra and was awarded her PhD in Portuguese Studies at Universidade Nova de Lisboa. She is currently Associate Professor at Universidade Nova de Lisboa. She has carried out activities predominantly in the area of Cultural History and Society with a particular focus on Cultural topics, Slavery and the Slave Trade. She has published, among other works and papers, Viagem ao Fundo das Consciências. A Escravatura na Época Moderna. Lisboa, Colibri, 1995 (338 pages), which is a version of her PhD thesis, and Chão de Sombras. Estudos sobre Escravatura, Lisboa, Colibri, 2010 (200 pages).

She is currently a researcher in the fields of Portuguese Culture and History of Slavery and is a senior researcher at CHAM. Member of, Sociedade Portuguesa de Estudos do Século XVIII, and its international branch, Sociedade Internacional de Estudos do séc. XVIII, as well as with the Portuguese Committee for the UNESCO Project Slave route. Author of two monographies on slavery, editor of 5 proceedings on Portuguese Culture and Literature, and more than 20 articles published in national and international journals.
