

Prof. Dr. Maria João Durão, Lisbon, 196, has a Diploma in Fine Arts, Faculty of Fine Arts, Lisbon University; obtained Ph.D. degree from The University of Salford, Manchester, UK (2000) funded by PRODEP; was granted equivalence to *doutoramento* in Scientific Area of Desenho e Comunicação Visual, Faculdade de Arquitectura de Lisboa, Universidade Técnica de Lisboa.
