Szymon Wróbel is a full professor of philosophy at the Faculty of *Artes Liberales* at the University of Warsaw and the Institute of Philosophy and Sociology of the Polish Academy of Sciences. He is the author of numerous books and articles scattered in various scientific journals. His books in English include: *Deferring the Self* and *Grammar and Glamor of Cooperation*, published in 2013 and 2015. In Polish: Ćwiczenia z przyjaźni (Exercises in Friendship), Lektury retroaktywne (Retroactive Readings) and Polska pozycja depresyjna (Polish Depressive Position) published by Kraków Publishing House Universitas. In 2016, IFiS PAN published his book, *Filozof i terytorium* (Philosopher and Territory) on the Warsaw School of Historians of Ideas. Together with Krzysztof Skonieczny, he is co-editor of three books – *Atheism Revisited. Rethinking Modernity and Inventing New Modes of Life* (Palgrave Macmillan 2020) and *Living and Thinking in the Post-Digital World* (Universitas 2021), *Regimes of Capital in the Postdigital Age* (Routledge, forthcoming). Currently, he is the head of the experimental Laboratory of Techno-Humanities at the Faculty of *Artes Liberales* where for several years he realizes the "Technology and Socialization" project.
